Track Rules

Track rules have been updated. Two changes have been made to the rules. Safety Regulations section number 13, No saving of pit spots. Race Procedures section number 21, If a driver goes out for their feature with a transponder that is known not working after the heats and was warned by RaceCeiver or track official, they will be disqualified from the feature. If for some reason your transponder quit working after your heat race or during the feature race and it is unknown to you and the track officials you cannot be disqualified from your feature race. Any driver that wishes to have their transponder checked should contact a track official, you will be allowed to drive your car across the transponder line by the flag stand to check its working status during intermission. If for some reason your transponder is not working you can rent one for the remainder of the night for \$30. Zach lutz motioned to approve the updated track rules. Seconded by Steve Peirce. Pit Stalls

Brandon Beeter read through the pit stall rules that we are following for ONLY the 2015 season. In 2016 we will have a more concrete set of rules on how the selling of pit stall parking will go.

1. IT IS NOT A REQUIREMENT TO PURCHASE A RESERVED PIT STALL
2. THERE WILL NOT BE SPOT SAVING IN THE PITS ANYMORE
3. IF YOU SAVE SPOTS YOU WILL BE ASKED TO REMOVE THE OBJECT THAT YOU ARE SAVING SPOTS WITH IMMEDIATELY
4. IF YOU CHOOSE NOT TO PURCHASE A RESERVED PIT STALL, IT WILL BE FIRST COME FIRST SERVE ON THE UNSOLD PIT STALLS ON RACE NIGHTS BUT STILL NO SPOT SAVING
